A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRECURSORS TO THE MANUFACTURE OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 329-70, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$329-70[+] Forfeiture. (a) Precursor chemicals that
- 4 are possessed, transferred, sold, or offered for sale in
- 5 violation of this part shall be subject to seizure and
- 6 forfeiture as provided in chapter 712A.
- 7 (b) All conveyances, including aircraft, vehicles, or
- 8 vessels that are used, or intended for use, to transport or in
- 9 any manner facilitate the transportation of precursor chemicals
- 10 for a purpose that would constitute a violation of section
- 11 329-65(c) or (d), shall be subject to seizure and forfeiture as
- 12 provided in chapter 712A.
- 13 (c) All moneys, negotiable instruments, securities, or
- 14 other things of value furnished or intended to be furnished by
- 15 any person in exchange for any of the substances listed in
- 16 section 329-61, all proceeds traceable to such an exchange, and
- 17 all moneys, negotiable instruments, and securities used or



- 1 intended to be used to facilitate any violation of section
- 2 329-65(c) or (d), shall be subject to seizure and forfeiture as
- 3 provided in chapter 712A."
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 5 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 6 begun, before its effective date.
- 7 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2060.
