RELATING TO TORT ACTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 663-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"§663-10.5 Government entity as a tortfeasor; public 3 utility as tortfeasor; abolition of joint and several liability. 4 5 Any other law to the contrary notwithstanding, including but not limited to sections 663-10.9, 663-11 to 663-13, 663-16, 663-17, 6 and 663-31, in any case where a government entity is determined 7 to be a tortfeasor along with one or more other tortfeasors, the 8 9 government entity shall be liable for no more than that percentage share of the damages attributable to the government 10 entity [; provided that joint and several liability shall be 11 retained for tort claims relating to the maintenance and design 12 13 of highways pursuant to section 663-10.9]. In any case where a public utility is one of the tortfeasors, the public utility 14 shall be liable for no more than that percentage share of the 15 16 damages attributable to the public utility.

1 and any county or combination of counties, department, agency, institution, board, commission, district, council, bureau, 2 office, governing authority, or other instrumentality of state 3 or county government, or corporation or other establishment 4 5 owned, operated, or managed by or on behalf of this State or any county[-] and any professional consultant licensed pursuant to 6 chapter 464 contracted by the unit of government in this state. 7 For purposes of this section, "public utility" shall have 8 9 the same meaning set forth in section 269-1. For purposes of this section, the liability of a government 10 11 entity or public utility shall include its vicarious liability 12 for the acts or omissions of its officers and employees." 13 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 14 begun, before its effective date. 15 SECTION 3.
