## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RECYCLING.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 201-102, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§201-102 Advisory committees.** (a) The director of  
4 business, economic development, and tourism [~~may~~] shall form  
5 advisory committees to assist in the formulation of  
6 recommendations concerning the development of markets for  
7 recycled materials[~~-~~] and programs to implement and encourage  
8 statewide recycling. The recommendations shall address the  
9 removal of impediments to, as well as the establishment of  
10 incentives for, the use of recycled materials by businesses or  
11 energy producers in order to expand markets for recyclable  
12 materials.

13           (b) At the discretion of the director, committee members  
14 may include, but need not be limited to:

15           (1) The director of health;

16           (2) The director of [~~the office of planning~~] business,  
17 economic development, and tourism;
