

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 132D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"\$132D-10 Permits. A permit shall be required for the
4	purchase and use of:
5	(1) Any consumer fireworks commonly known as firecrackers
6	upon payment of a fee of [\$25;] <u>\$10;</u> and
7	(2) Any aerial devices, display fireworks, or articles
8	pyrotechnic for the purposes of section 132D-16 upon
9	payment of a fee of \$110."
10	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
12	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
