SECTION 1. Section 235-55.85, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsection (f) to read as follows: 2 "(f) All claims for tax credits under this section, 3 including any amended claims, shall be filed on or before the 4 end of the [twelfth] thirty-sixth month following the close of 5 the taxable year for which the credits may be claimed. Failure to comply with the foregoing provision shall constitute a waiver 7 of the right to claim the credit." 8 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2008.
