9	life force and give consideration to the "Aloha Spirit"[$-$].
10	steadfastly contemplating and asking whether each of their
11	actions, including what they think, do, say, or decide:
12	(1) Is the truth;
13	(2) Is fair to all concerned;
14	(3) Will build good will and better relationships; and
15	(4) Will be beneficial to all concerned."
