

# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Section 281-59, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 SECTION 1. amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2 Upon the day of hearing, or any adjournment thereof, 3 the liquor commission shall consider the application and any 4 protests and objections to the granting thereof, and hear the 5 parties in interest. The liquor commission shall accept all 6 written or oral testimony for or against the application whether 7 the application is denied, refused, or withdrawn. 8 fifteen days after the hearing, or within thirty days thereafter 9 if in its discretion the commission extends the fifteen days to 10 thirty days, and gives public notice of same, the commission 11 shall give its decision granting or refusing the application; 12 provided that if a majority of the: 13 Registered voters for the area within five hundred 14 (1)

feet of the nearest point of the premises for which

the license is asked; or
