BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The department of public safety shall conduct a
- 2 statewide study on the feasibility of an integrated approach to
- 3 affordable housing, a private corrections facility focusing on
- 4 rehabilitation, innovative agricultural systems, and waste
- 5 management solutions in planned communities statewide.
- 6 The department of public safety shall submit a report of
- 7 its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 8 legislation, no later than twenty days prior to the regular
- 9 session of 2008.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
