A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO ASSIST IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN IRRIGATION PIPE IN WAIMANALO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 2 moneys as a grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised
- 3 Statutes, to assist the Waimanalo Corn Farm on Oahu by
- 4 constructing an irrigation pipe from the water reservoir to the
- 5 farm in order to provide the farm with water throughout the year
- 6 seven days a week.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$400,000, or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, as a
- 10 grant pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for the
- 11 construction of an irrigation pipe from the reservoir in
- 12 Waimanalo to the Waimanalo Corn Farm.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
