BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public private 2 partnerships are an effective tool in implementing state 3 programs and projects. Private entities who have partnered with 4 the State to successfully build state facilities such as school 5 buildings are valuable assets that should be encouraged. 6 The purpose of this Act is to improve the efficiency and 7 effectiveness of public construction projects by authorizing a 8 purchasing agency to enter into public-private partnerships for
