- 3 as follows:
- 4 "S Indigenous and maoli people; Hawaii. The
- 5 descendants of the races inhabiting the islands of Hawaii, Maui,
- 6 Molokai, Lanai, Kahoolawe, Oahu, Kauai, Niihau, and Nihoa to
- 7 Kanemilohai or Kure Atoll, prior to western contact in 1778 are
- 8 recognized as the native, indigenous, aboriginal, and maoli
- 9 people of the islands of Hawaii."
- 10 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
