### H.B. NO. 20

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. As a result of implementing Act 51, Session 2 Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended by Act 221, Session Laws of 3 Hawaii 2004, as amended by Act 225, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, 4 section 302A-1115, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is no longer 5 required to decentralize and restructure the department of 6 education. Under Act 51, as amended, the number and kind of 7 positions at the school level is determined by the individual 8 school due to the implementation of the weighted student 9 formula. Act 51 also provides the department of education with 10 the authority to transfer positions within the department, and with the transfer of certain functions from the department of 11 12 human resources development, the department carries out 13 personnel functions as a separate jurisdiction.

Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to repeal section302A-1115, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

16 SECTION 2. Section 302A-1115, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 repealed.
