### A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION RELATING TO EDUCATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose an
2	amendment to article X, section 2, of the Constitution of the
3	State of Hawaii to require:
4	(1) The board of education to be composed of seventeen
5	voting members elected in a nonpartisan manner by the
6	qualified voters of the respective school board
7	districts, as provided by law; and
8	(2) Each school board district to be composed of three
9	representative districts.
10	SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of
11	the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
12	"BOARD OF EDUCATION
13	Section 2. There shall be a board of education composed of
14	seventeen voting members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan
15	manner by the qualified voters[, as provided by law, from two
16	at-large school board districts. The first school board
17	district shall be comprised of the island of Oahu and all other
