## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A SALARY INCREASE FOR TEACHERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary,

  there is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State

  for Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so much thereof as may be

  necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009, to
- 6 provide a two per cent salary increase for each fiscal year for
- 7 all teachers, as that term is defined under section 302A-101,
- 8 Hawaii Revised Statutes, who are employed by the department of
- 9 education; provided that the salary increase shall also include
- $10\,$  a cost of living adjustment at least equal to the rate of
- 11 inflation (since the most recent salary increase) as determined
- 12 by the United States of Bureau of Labor Statistics' consumer
- 13 price index of Honolulu.
- 14 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 15 of education for the purposes of this Act.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
