A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOLIDAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as follows:
4	" <u>§8-</u> Peace Day. September 21 of each year shall be
5	known and recognized as peace day. All citizens shall be
6	encouraged to observe and celebrate the blessings of peace and
7	endeavor to create peace on peace day. Peace Day shall serve as
8	a focal point to promote peace programs, improve international
9	relations, and increase educational awareness of peace and shall
10	include discussions of the professional activities and
11	achievements in the lives of peacemakers."
12	SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended
13	to read as follows:
14	"§8-1 Holidays designated. The following days of each
15	year are set apart and established as state holidays:
16	The first day in January, New Year's Day;
17	The third Monday in January, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.,
