A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COUNTIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding	a new section to be appropriately designated and to
3	read as f	ollows:
4	" <u>§46</u>	- Indemnification of county agencies. (a) To
5	receive c	ounty aid, assistance, support, benefits, services, and
6	interests	in or rights to use county property, a state agency
7	may agree	in writing to an indemnity provision by which the
8	State agr	ees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless a county
9	agency, i	ts officers, agents, and employees when:
10	(1)	A county ordinance, rules, or regulations expressly or
11		by clear implication require the indemnity provision;
12	(2)	The governor approves the State's proposed indemnity
13		provision;
14	(3)	The comptroller, pursuant to section 41D-8.5, has
15		obtained an insurance policy or policies in an amount
16		sufficient to cover the liability of the State that
17		reasonably may be anticipated to arise under the
18		indemnity provision or has determined that it is not

1		in the best interest of the State to obtain insurance;	
2		<u>and</u>	
3	(4)	The State's liability under the indemnity provision	
4		will be expressly limited to the amount of, and will	
5		be defrayed solely by, such insurance.	
6	(b)	An indemnity provision not in strict compliance with	
7	this section shall not give rise to a claim against the State		
8	under chapter 661 or otherwise waive the State's sovereign		
9	immunity."		
10	SECTION 2. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
11	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
12	and to read as follows:		
13	" <u>§</u> 66	3- County agency; limited liability. No county	
14	agency, i	ts officers, agents, and employees providing aid,	
15	assistanc	e, support, benefits, services, and interests in or	
16	rights to use county property to a state agency shall be liable		
17	for any civil damages resulting from the acts or omissions of		
18	the county agency's officers, agents, or employees occurring		
19	during the course of providing aid, assistance, support,		
20	benefits,	services, and interests in or rights to use county	
21	property	to the state agency, except for damages that may result	

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    from the gross negligence or wanton acts or omissions of the
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    agency's officers, agents, or employees."

State Indemnification; County Assistance

Description:

Authorizes state agencies to indemnify county agencies and statutorily limits the civil liability of a county agency when the state agency receives from the county agency aid, assistance, support, benefits, service, or interest in or rights to use county property under certain circumstances. Authorizes the Comptroller to obtain loss insurance to indemnify a county.
