## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SUBSTANCE ABUSE TREATMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that at least eighty per 2 cent of inmates at Hawaii prisons and jails have a substance 3 abuse problem and that not all inmates receive the substance abuse treatment they need. The purpose of this Act is to 4 provide substance abuse treatment for inmates needing substance 5 abuse treatment services prior to being released back to our 6 7 communities. SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 8 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ , or so much 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 11 12 2008-2009, for substance abuse treatment for inmates at 13 correctional facilities or at Hawaii community correctional 14 centers.
- The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department of public safety for the purposes of this Act.
