BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 163D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending the definition of "agriculture" to read as
follows:

""Agriculture" means the production for marketing and 4 exporting of plant and animal life on land and within ponds and 5 other bodies of water for food, fiber, and raw materials for 6 7 value-added products, and any agricultural enterprise or enterprises organized for the production of agricultural 8 materials or value-added products based on detailed marketing 9 analysis and strategies to exploit profitable potentials in 10 local, national, and international markets, including general 11 farming, cane growing, fruit growing, flower growing, 12 aquaculture, growing of timber and forest products, apiary, 13 arazing, growing of crops for fuel or the production of energy, 14 15 dairying, and the production of any form of livestock or poultry, and their appurtenant services and facilities." 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored. 17




