## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 167-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

3	"(d)	Landowners may apply for funding assistance from the

6	(1)	Provides matching funding equal to the amount received

9	[ <del>(2)</del>	Agrees to file a petition for declaratory ruling

12		irrigation system as important agricultural lands as	
13		defined under section 205-42 and notifies the board	
14		and county of the petition and designation for the	
15		purpose of inclusion on maps; and]	
16	(2)	Dedicates the land to be served by the irrigation	
17		system funded under this section to agricultural use

1		for no fewer than ten years pursuant to county

3	(3)	Agrees to <u>actively</u> use, or provide for the <u>active</u> use	
4		of, all such lands for agricultural production if

### Report Title:

Irrigation Repair and Maintenance Special Fund

#### Description:

Requires landowners applying for funding assistance from the Irrigation Repair and Maintenance Special Fund to dedicate the land to be irrigated to agricultural use for no fewer than ten years. Repeals existing requirement that the landowner file a petition for declaratory ruling designating a majority of all land served by the irrigation system as important agricultural land. (HB406 HD1)
