## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 4 "(a) As used in this section, "fundraiser" means any
- 5 function held for the benefit of a person that is intended or
- 6 designed, directly or indirectly, to raise funds for political

- 8 attending the function is more than \$25 per person].
- 9 (b) There shall be no more than two fundraisers held for a
- 10 person prior to a general or special election in which that
- 11 person is either elected or defeated.
- 12 A person who is an elected state legislator and is seeking
- 13 re-election to a state legislative office shall not hold a
- 14 fundraiser during a regular legislative session or special
- 15 session."
- 16 2. By amending subsection (d) to read:
- "(d) Fundraisers sponsored by a candidate for a statewide
- 18 office are exempt from the [\$25 + 1imit + of + subsection + (a) + and + the]



- 1 restrictions of subsection (b)[ and fundraisers sponsored].
- 2 Fundraisers sponsored by a party for a political purpose for the
- ${f 3}$  general benefit of the party are exempt from the restrictions of
- 4 subsection (b)."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
