## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE CENTER ON GERONTOLOGY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the mission of the
- 2 center on aging research and education is to assure the well-
- 3 being of the State's older adults by stimulating and
- 4 coordinating gerontological and aging instruction, research, and
- 5 community services.
- 6 Currently, there is an urgent need to engage in
- 7 gerontological research given the radical demographic shifts
- 8 related to the growing aging population in Hawaii and in the
- 9 Asia/Pacific region.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for five
- 11 faculty positions for the center of gerontology at the
- 12 University of Hawaii at Manoa.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$350,000, or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 16 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
