A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$304A- Classroom instruction; earliest start.
- 5 Beginning on the first day of instruction of the fall semester
- 6 of 2007, for the purpose of reducing traffic congestion on Oahu,
- 7 no classroom instruction at the University of Hawaii-Manoa
- 8 campus shall begin earlier than 9 a.m. during weekdays."
- 9 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on August 20, 2007.
