A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§150A-A Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
5	charge. (a) The department shall prescribe a schedule of
6	service fees and charges and collect appropriate service fees or
7	charges for pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication
8	services from any person who imports any article, container, or
9	packing material as described in section 150A-5, or means of
10	conveyance. The department shall establish a schedule of
11	service fees and charges to ensure that the service is
12	commensurate with the costs of inspection, quarantine, and
13	eradication services.
14	(b) If an importer of commercial shipments subject to the
15	service fees or charges under this section fails to pay the

service fee or charge when due, the department shall assess a

late payment penalty.

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1	<u>(c)</u>	The service fees, charges, and penalties collected by		
2	the depar	tment under this section shall be deposited into the		
3	pest insp	ection, quarantine, and eradication fund.		
4	<u>§150</u>	A-B Pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund.		
5	(a) Ther	e is established in the state treasury the pest		
6	inspectio	on, quarantine, and eradication fund, into which shall		
7	be deposited:			
8	<u>(1)</u>	Legislative appropriations for inspection and		
9		quarantine services;		
10	(2)	Service fees, charges, and penalties collected under		
11		section 150A-A;		
12	(3)	Federal funds received for pest inspection,		
13		quarantine, and eradication programs;		
14	(4)	All interest earned on accrued moneys deposited in the		
15		pest inspection and quarantine treatment services		
16		fund;		
17	(5)	Grants and gifts; and		
18	(6)	Any other moneys made available to the pest inspection		
19		and quarantine treatment services fund from any other		
20		sources.		
21	<u>(b)</u>	The moneys in the pest inspection, quarantine, and		
22	eradicati	on fund shall be used by the department for the		
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- 1 operation of inspection and monitoring programs, related
- 2 facilities, and the execution of emergency remedial measures
- 3 when pests are detected in the course of inspection and
- 4 quarantine activities by the department."
- 5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the pest
- 6 inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund the sum of
- 7 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 8 year 2007-2008 for the operation or inspection and monitoring
- 9 programs, related facilities, and the execution of emergency
- 10 remedial measures when pests are detected in the course of
- 11 inspection and quarantine activities.
- 12 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 13 agriculture for the purposes of section 150A-B, Hawaii Revised
- 14 Statutes.
- 15 SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
- 16 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
- 17 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
- 18 the new sections in this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 20 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
