Section 663-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: "(a) Noneconomic damages, which are recoverable in tort 3 actions if the plaintiff can prove that the defendant was at 4 5 least grossly negligent, include damages for pain and suffering, mental anguish, disfigurement, loss of enjoyment of life, loss 6 of consortium, and all other nonpecuniary losses or claims." 7 SECTION 2.
