A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part VII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S291C- Solicitation by pedestrians on a highway
- 5 **prohibited.** No pedestrian shall sell or solicit sale of
- 6 services or goods to any occupant of a vehicle on a highway, or
- 7 accept donation or solicit donation of money or goods from any
- 8 occupant of a vehicle on a highway, while the pedestrian is on
- 9 the highway or its right of way."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 12 begun, before its effective date.
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
