A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ARMED SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 249, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§249- Exemption for national guard, military reserves,
- 5 and other active duty military personnel claiming Hawaii as
- 6 their residence of record. One noncommercial motor vehicle
- 7 registered to a member of the national guard, military reserve,
- 8 or armed service, including the Coast Guard, who is:
- 9 (1) Assigned to a unit in the State; and
- 10 (2) A member in good standing,
- 11 shall be exempt from the vehicle weight tax provided for in this
- 12 chapter."
- 13 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2008.
