SilverFin by Charlie Higson (a YA prequel to 007's adult adventures)





A mischievous girl accuses her older sister's lover of a crime he did not commit in a film based on the best-selling 2002 novel by author Ian McEwan. The year is 1935, and as the summer heat takes hold, 13-year-old fledgling writer Briony Tallis watches her older sister, Cecilia, go frolicking in the garden fountain on her family's country estate. The housekeeper's son, Robbie, a childhood friend, also witnesses the innocent act. Following this incident, the scheming Briony accuses Robbie of an unspeakable transgression for which the boy is wholly innocent, the repercussions of her unfounded claim threaten to affect all three for decades to come. (Runtime: 2) hours 10 minutes. Rated R for disturbing war images, language and some sexuality.)

An Instinctive Solution: An Inspector Alvarez Mystery by Roderic Jeffries F Jeffries

In this 32nd Inspector Alvarez mystery, the Majorcan Inspector is called upon to investigate the death of a woman found shot dead in her own home, with all the evidence seeming to point to her husband's guilt. But Alvarez believes that Herod is

not guilty, and the Inspector is forced to take a risk in the belief that justice should take precedence over the law . . .

Death Will Get You Sober by Elizabeth Zelvin F Zelvin

When homeless alcoholics start to die unexpectedly, Dr. Bruce Kohler, recovering alcoholic himself, wants to find out why. As Bruce grapples with staying sober, he finds that not drinking is only the beginning of coming back to life---a life he

finds he wants to keep when it's threatened by a killer.

A Deadly Paradise: A Commissario Cenni Investigation by Grace Brophy F Brophy

In this sequel to *The Last Enemy*, Inspector Cenni finds himself investigating the murder of an elderly German woman, resident of the Umbrian village of Paradiso. Some of the dead woman's secrets may have been acquired long ago, during

World War II. And the bucolic village is not that innocent: It was the site of a famous, scandalous murder fifty years earlier.


