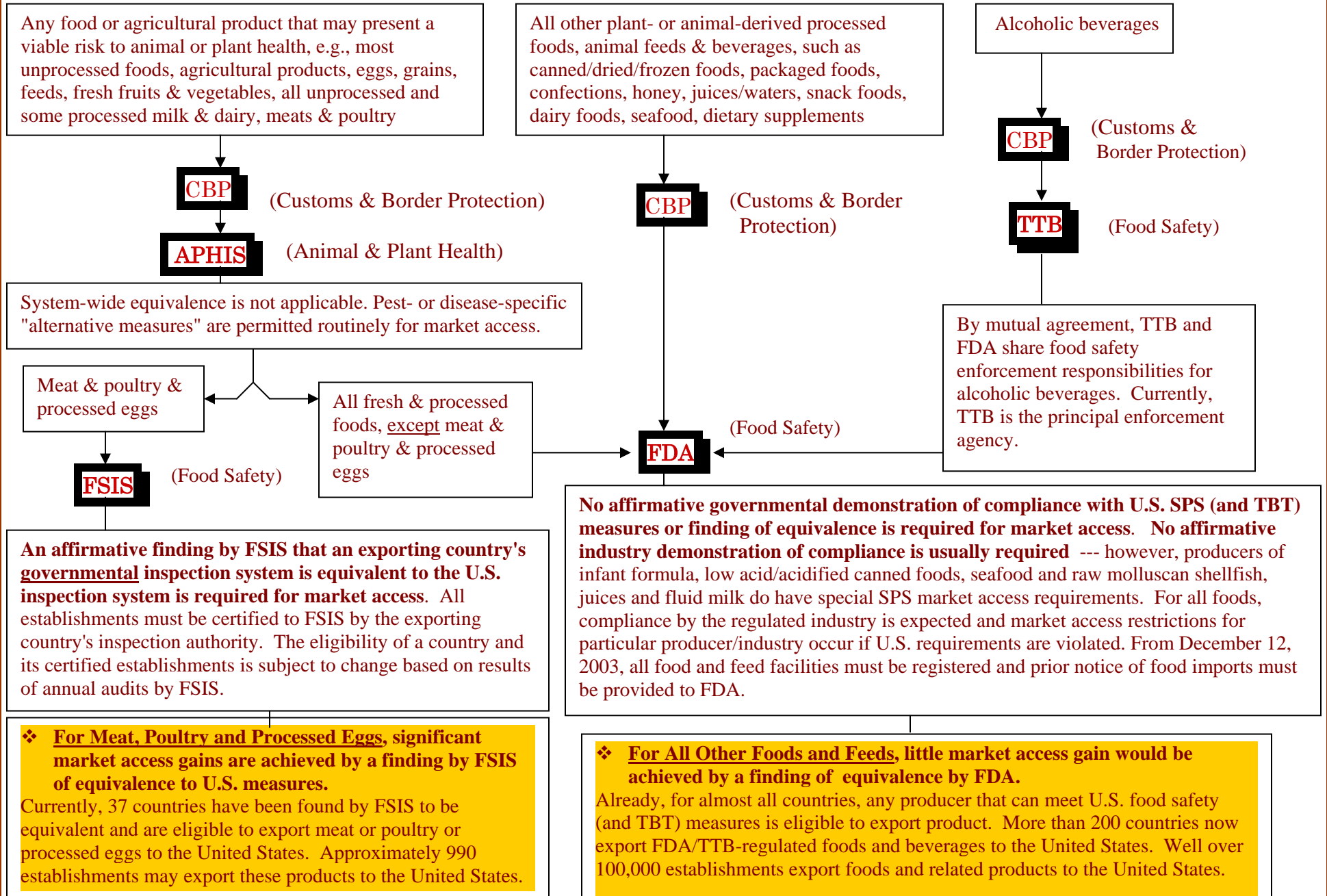


U.S. SPS Market Access Pathways* for Foods, Feeds and Agricultural Products

- **Customs and Border Protection (CBP) is an agency of the Department of Homeland Security (DHS)**
- **The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is an agency of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)**
- **The Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) is an agency of the Department of Agriculture (USDA)**
- **The Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) is an agency of the Department of Agriculture (USDA)**
- **The Alcohol and Tobacco Tax and Trade Bureau (TTB) is an agency of the Department of the Treasury**
- **SPS -- "Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures" as defined in the World Trade Organization Agreement on the Application of Sanitary and Phytosanitary Measures**
- **TBT -- "Technical Barriers to Trade" as defined in the World Trade Organization Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade**
