The New Foreign Trade Regulations - <u>Mandatory</u> Automated Export System Filing Requirements Are Here!

NTCBFFA is sponsoring an Automated Export System (AES) Compliance Seminar and Workshop in Dallas, TX. The U.S. Census Bureau and port officers from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) will participate as presenters.
