Non driver ID Program

A person of **any age** may apply for a **Non-Driver Photo ID Card** at any of our 12 Auto Bureau offices throughout Erie County. (go to our home page and use our clickable map to find your closest Auto Bureau)

How to Apply:

To apply you must complete an application for Driver Licence/ID Card (MV-44) available at all Erie County Auto Bureaus and at www.nysdmv.com

Proof of Identity:

You Must provide: Original Birth Certificate
Original Social Security Card
Parent(s) Signature and
Parent(s) Identification
(N.Y.S. Drivers License)

Cost to Apply:

Cost for child: \$9.50 - \$10.00 (depending on date of birth)

1. **Call Police Immediately.**
2. Show Police **NYS Non Driver ID card.**
3. Alert Friends, Neighbors and Relatives.

4. search your house (checking closets,
piles of laundry and under beds.
5. Check Child's Favorite Play Area.
