IN RE: REDACTION OF OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPT

Transcripts of proceedings before the U.S. District Judges and Magistrate Judges in the Western District of Kentucky taken by Official Court Reporters and Contract Court Reporters are now filed with the Court in electronic format. Pursuant to the Procedures for Official Court Transcripts and the Notice Regarding Electronic Availability of Official Court Transcripts and the Redaction Responsibilities of Counsel and Parties, Joint General Order 08-01, it is the responsibility of the parties and counsel to review the Official Court Transcript for redaction and provide the requested redactions to the Court Reporter. In the interest of the administrative efficiency of the Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That upon the written request of an attorney or a *pro se* litigant, the Clerk of Court, or designee, is authorized to grant an initial fourteen (14) day extension of time for the submission of the Statement of Redaction to the Court Reporter and the filing of the Certificate of Service with the Court. Any subsequent motions must be submitted to the presiding judge for review. The Court Reporter shall be given ten (10) days from the receipt of the Statement of Redaction and the filing of the Certificate of Service to file the redacted transcript.
- 2. That upon the written request of a Court Reporter, the Clerk of Court, or designee, is authorized to grant an initial fourteen (14) day extension of time for the filing of

the redacted transcript. Any subsequent motions must be submitted to the presiding judge for review.

 Statements of Redaction filed with the Court shall be stricken from the record and served upon the Court Reporter.
