AMENDMENT TO GENERAL ORDER 2008-02

RE: EX PARTE APPLICATIONS FOR ENFORCEMENT

To promote the effective collection of debts owed to the United States and victims of federal crimes, the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Western District of Kentucky is authorized to file a Notice of Ex Parte application for enforcement pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1651 and 3202(a) (The All Writs Act and applications for writs of execution and garnishment, respectively).

Once the U.S. Attorney's Office has given notice to the debtor, it shall file a Certificate of Service with the Court. The matter may be unsealed by any one of the following events: (1) the filing of the Certificate of Service on debtor or garnishee; (2) an answer by the garnishee; or (3) a request for hearing by the debtor.
