Because of the phase-in requirements, rate period and contract term limits it is unlikely that a large new public would be receiving its share of Tier 1 power even by the end of the proposed contract period in 2031. We do not believe this is reasonable or in the spirit of the law. At a minimum the 50 aMW cap per rate period and the 250 aMW cap for the contract period should be removed. These two limits are expressly aimed at large new publics. The only purpose they serve is to deprive large new publics from the same opportunities enjoyed by all other public utilities served by BPA.
