## **General Plan survey heading to Lodi mailboxes**

Every Lodi household will soon receive a survey that will help city planners update Lodi's General Plan, the blueprint for the city's future growth.

The full-color brochures are scheduled for mailing Wednesday (June 6) and should begin appearing in mailboxes shortly after. They are printed in English and Spanish.

The survey explains the process behind the General Plan update and asks residents to become a part of a process that will create a long-term plan for Lodi's future. Respondents will be asked where and how they want Lodi to grow and state their preferences for city programs and services. Residents can return the postage-paid survey anonymously through the mail by folding and sealing it as marked.

In case a household does not receive the survey, one may be obtained at Lodi City Hall, 221 W. Pine St., from the Community Development Department.

The first General Plan update workshop, Issues and Visioning, is scheduled at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, June 13, at Hutchins Street Square's Kirst Hall, 125 S. Hutchins St.

Lodi last updated its General Plan in 1991. All cities are required by state law to adopt general plans, which cover topics from growth to jobs and environmental quality.
