STANDING ORDER NO. 8

In all cases, whether in the Western Division or in Kane County, for which a motion is sought to be presented as an emergency matter pursuant to Local Rule 5096-1, the proposed motion shall set forth the nature of the matter such that the delay in hearing it in the ordinary course would cause serious and irreparable harm to one or more of the parties to the proceeding. In addition, an affidavit executed by either a party or counsel shall accompany the motion setting forth the emergency nature and designating the time within which the motion must be heard to avoid serious and irreparable harm. A copy of the motion and affidavit shall be faxed to Judge Barbosa's Chambers. After review and approval, the party that filed the motion and affidavit will be notified of the day and time approved for an emergency hearing. That party shall then notice the date and time of hearing to all necessary parties.
