IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective immediately, that any party moving pursuant to 11 U.S.C §350 and Bankruptcy Rule 5010 to reopen a Chapter 7 case in order to file the debtor's certification required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(b)(7) must simultaneously and separately file Official Form B23 and set forth the following:

- a) the reason the certification was not filed before the case was closed; and
- b) who [attorney or debtor(s)] paid the fee to reopen the case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed order appended to the motion shall state that the case is reopened for the purposes of filing the certification and entering the discharge and that the clerk is to close the case thereafter.
