Florida Sea Grant is a statewide academic program for coastal research, extension, and education. The University of Florida serves as a host campus for the program, which represents partnership of universities, marine industries, citizens and government. The Sea Grant Extension Program is jointly managed with the Florida Cooperative Extension Service, Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences at the University of Florida. Extension

agents provide programs for various audiences in seafood technology, marine economics, coastal engineering, coastal hazards awareness, fishing conservation, clean boating/marina practices, and marine environmental stewardship. Sea Grant extension agents promote the practical use and conservation of marine resources to create a sustainable economy and environment. Through seminars, workshops, publications, local marine advisory committees, and person-to-person contact, agents bring results of university research to user groups within your local coastal county.
