SIX MONTHS SUMMARY -- OCTOBER 2000 THROUGH MARCH 2001 AND CASES CLOSED MARCH 2001

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges.
