

# OCRWM Mission

The U.S. Department of Energy Office of Civilian Radioactive Waste Management

- <u>Mission</u>: Manage and dispose of high-level radioactive waste (HLW) and spent nuclear fuel (SNF) in a manner that protects public health, safety, and the environment; enhances national and energy security; and merits public confidence.
- Develop the Yucca Mountain Repository and related infrastructure to safely and permanently dispose of our Nation's HLW and SNF currently being stored at 121 sites in 39 states.



# Objectives of the President's FY 2009 Budget Request for Yucca Mountain

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## The request of \$494.7 million allows OCRWM to:

- Begin defense of the License Application.
- Further transform the OCRWM organization for its role in building and operating the repository and transportation systems.
- Advance the design of the repository in preparation for construction.
- > Advance the preliminary design for Nevada Rail.
- Continue stakeholder interactions and further develop the national transportation planning process.

# OCRWM FY 2009 Yucca Mountain Key Activities

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#### License Application Defense

Defend the License Application (LA) after submission.

#### **Repository Development**

Continue planning and design for facilities required for the receipt and emplacement of SNF and HLW in the repository.

#### Financial Assistance

- Maintain funding for oversight activities to Nevada and AULGs.
- Add funding for Timbisha-Shoshone.
