NRC Faculty Development Grant Program at the University of Tennessee

The Faculty Development Grant Program at the University of Tennessee (UT) will support two junior faculty members in the Nuclear Engineering Department. The requested budget is \$322,000 over a 3 year period. This budget includes support for new course development, developing proposals for research, equipment stipends, participation in professional society meetings, preparation of papers, travel, and other startup costs. The goal of this program is to attract highly-qualified faculty members, develop these faculty members to be excellent in research and teaching, and then retain them so that UT may be better equipped to meet the nation's need to train and equip a new generation of nuclear engineers and health physicists.
