Nuclear Technician Training Program

Executive Summary

New Mexico Junior College (NMJC) in Lea County, New Mexico received a grant from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission in 2007. The primary purpose of the grant was to establish a Nuclear Technician Training Program. New Mexico Junior College is requesting funds over a one-year period to continue the integration of a nuclear energy curriculum; expand the training modules to enhance workers skills in nuclear safety, security, and environmental protection; and articulate the program with secondary education. NMJC will deliver these programs in traditional classrooms, workshops, focused training sessions, and via the NMJC ITV and Distance Learning Network, that serves the region.
