RPI-NRC Fellowship Program

With the assistance of the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute (RPI) will offer a Fellowship program for graduate students interested in pursuing careers in the nuclear and radiological engineering fields. Students that are awarded RPI-NRC Fellowships will receive a full tuition waiver and a calendar year stipend of \$25,000. Fellowships will be awarded for one year, and may be renewed for one additional year, provided the student makes sufficient academic process. RPI will award up to two fellowships per year, over four years. The RPI-NRC Fellowship Program will promote two important goals that support the development of the nuclear workforce. By supporting new graduate students, the fellowship will encourage advanced training and experience for those entering the nuclear field. Additionally, the fellowship opportunities will increase the interest in graduate nuclear engineering study, leading to a greater number and diversity of those being trained in nuclear technology.
