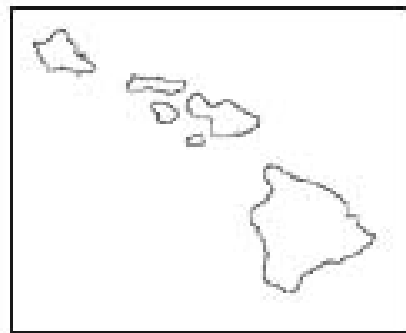
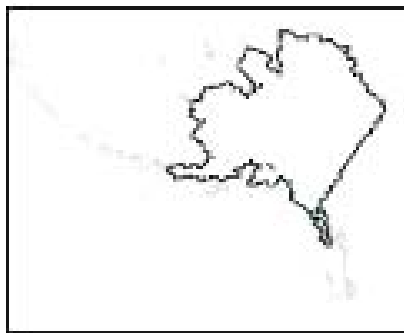

Training:

- Designed and developed with learning outcomes/objectives
- Learning outcomes/objectives will be achieved during the class
- Measured throughout the session
- Assessed at the end of session to make sure learning knowledge and skills have been achieved
- Learner Centered

Presentations:

- Developed to deliver information (Awareness)
- Designed with a specific objective in mind
- Knowledge based
- Passive
- Knowledge is not measured at the end of the session

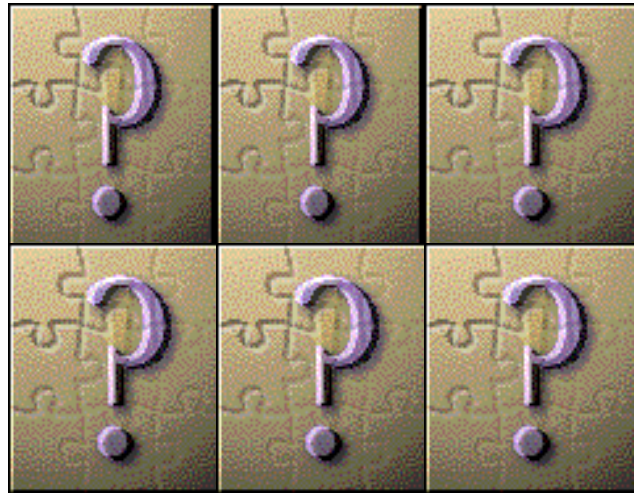
- Based upon customer feedback, NHI launched the *Real Solutions* seminars in March
