 - Guide will be distributed to OECM and DOE-CEG at same time for review
 - Final draft should be distributed within next few weeks
 - Review Process—comments should be e-mailed to Ross. Focus on “show stoppers”
 - The intent of the Cost Estimating Guide revision is to replace the existing Cost Guide and to be more current and useful.
