<u>PACIFIC COAST GROUNDFISH FISHERY</u> Correction to limited entry trawl trip limit tables

In a July 20, 2007 public notice (NMFS-SEA-07-06), the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) announced changes to commercial management measures for the Pacific Coast groundfish fishery off Washington, Oregon, and California, effective at 0001 hours (local time) August 1, 2007.

Trip limit Table 3 (North) and Table 3 (South) had publication errors that showed several lines in the table as blank. Corrections to these mistakes are described below.

Limited Entry Trawl Fishery

Formatting errors in line 41, line 50, and line 58 of Table 3 (North), and line 33-38 and line 44 of Table 3 (South), caused several trip limits to appear blank. None of the trip limits affected by this formatting error were modified by the August 1 inseason adjustments to fishery management measures. Therefore, this notice restores the previous values that were distributed in public notices earlier this year. The corrected trip limit tables, Table 3 (North) and Table 3 (South), are included at the end of this public notice.

For complete regulations governing the commercial groundfish fishery, please see Title 50 CFR Part 660, Subpart G. For more detailed regulations applying to the limited entry trawl fishery, see § 660.381 of the Pacific Coast groundfish regulations.

Table 3 (North) and Table 3 (South), effective August 1, 2007, are included at the end of this public notice.
