PACIFIC COAST GROUNDFISH FISHERY

SHORESIDE WHITING EXEMPTED FISHING PERMIT (EFP)

VESSEL OWNER AND FIRST RECEIVER MEETINGS

On March 28, 2008, NMFS published a Federal Register Notice (73 FR 16642) on its intent to issue an Exempted Fishing Permit (EFP) for both Pacific whiting first receivers and vessels in the 2008 fishery. NMFS will accept all comments received by April 14, 2008. NMFS Northwest Region and the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) are transitioning the Pacific Whiting Shoreside Fishery to a federally managed maximized retention and monitoring program (Amendment 10). Although it was expected that the program would be in place at the start of the 2008 fishing season, it will not be possible given the complexity of the rulemaking and other unanticipated workload. Therefore, NMFS is proposing a transitional EFP whose purpose would be to investigate the new components of the overall monitoring program before regulatory implementation.

Pending public comments, the intent of NMFS would be to require Pacific whiting shoreside fishery vessel owners and first receivers to obtain an EFP if they retain unsorted Pacific whiting catch for delivery or accept deliveries of unsorted Pacific whiting catch. NMFS has scheduled preseason meetings given below. All vessel owners/captains and first receivers are required to attend.
