AGE Council members of the Advocacy Group for Elders Program at The Senior Source wish to make the following comments about access to TV Converter Box Coupons.

All residents of facilities who have their own television sets should be able to apply and receive TV Converter Box Coupons at the facility they reside in. These residents may be of any age and live any facility (nursing home, assisted living, state school, group home, etc.).

Residents or their legally authorized representative should apply, and they should be able to use their name and address like all other citizens do. They should not have to provide a Social Security number or date of birth. The process should not be any different for them.

The coupons applied for should be for personal use and not for the use of the facility.
