RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 346-314, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 1
- amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 2
- "(a) A drug manufacturer or labeler that sells 3
- prescription drugs in the State [may] shall enter into a rebate 4
- agreement with the department for this purpose. The rebate 5
- agreement shall require the manufacturer or labeler to make 6
- rebate payments to the department each calendar quarter or 7
- according to a schedule established by the department." 8
- SECTION 2. Section 346-314, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9
- amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 10
- With respect to rebates effective July 1, [2005,] 11
- 2007, the administrator shall use the administrator's best 12
- efforts to obtain a rebate amount equal to or greater than the 13
- amount of any discount, rebate, or price reduction for 14
- prescription drugs provided to the federal government." 15
- SECTION 3. Section 346-315, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16
- amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 17

- 1 "(b) The department or administrator [may also] shall
- 2 provide to health care providers information about the relative
- 3 cost of drugs produced by manufacturers that enter into rebate
- 4 agreements compared to the cost of drugs produced by those that
- 5 do not enter into rebate agreements. The department shall adopt
- 6 rules under chapter 91 creating procedures for the
- 7 implementation of this section."
- 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
