## **HANFORD SITE WILL TEST EMERGENCY SIRENS**

The U.S. Department of Energy's Hanford Site will be testing emergency sirens at the 100 K Area as part of an emergency drill on Thursday, October 17, 1996, between 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Tests will consist of 3-minute siren soundings, preceded and followed by public address system announcements. Boaters on the Columbia River adjacent to the 100 K Area may hear the siren test, but no response is required.

Emergency drills and siren tests are conducted on the Hanford Site as part of the emergency response training program.
