FLUOR HANFORD EMPLOYEES DONATE MORE THAN \$47,000 TO HURRICANE RELIEF

RICHLAND, Wash. – Oct. 5, 2005 – Fluor Hanford employees have raised more than \$47,000 to date for Hurricane Katrina relief through fundraising lunches and donations of personal leave time.

Fluor employee groups hosted a series of fundraising lunches across the Hanford Site. The Country Gentleman and Henry's restaurants provided food for nine of the lunches in September. The lunches raised more than \$27,600, including a Fluor corporate match of 50 cents for every dollar raised. In addition, Fluor Hanford employees have donated 364 personal time bank (PTB) hours valued at just over \$13,000, with another \$6,600 added by a Fluor corporate match of 50 cents to the dollar.

"A huge 'thank you' goes out to several hundred Hanford employees, along with the Country Gentleman and Henry's restaurants, for making these contributions," said Fluor Hanford President Ron Gallagher. "I'd also like to thank Hanford Atomic Metal Trades Council for participating in the drive to raise relief funds."

A prime contractor to the Department of Energy since 1996, Fluor Hanford has approximately 3,400 employees and manages several major activities at the Hanford Site, including dismantling former nuclear processing facilities, cleaning up the site's contaminated groundwater, retrieving and processing transuranic waste for off-site shipment, maintaining the site's infrastructure, and operating the Volpentest HAMMER Training & Education Center.
